6. Tournament channel is VHF 78
7. OPEN COMMUNICATIONS NO RESTRICTIONS
8. You must be in the pier heads by 1:30 PM and proceed directly to weigh-in at West Basin Marina
9. Please include the payable name you want on any payout check if you should win. All payouts that total more than \$600 will require a W-9 and you will receive a 1099.
